Re: The Earthquake Incident in Japan

Last Friday (March 11th), the greatest earthquake in record hit Japan and left serious damages. We received a number of messages of sympathies from people who worried about Japanese situation. We are deeply appreciated for all your concerns and encouragements.

Some exhibitors raised questions about the safety of Nagoya and affection from nuclear radiation since the current news are not about Nagoya area but majorly about Tokyo and Tohoku regions. We would like to announce our findings as below:

Nagoya is very safe.

- Nagoya area did not get any serious affection from the quake. Nagoya is located 650km away from the epicenter.
- The Tsunami didn't reach Nagoya area.
- Nagoya has already returned to the ordinary mode; transportations and electricity were a little or not affected from the quake.

The amount of radiation in Nagoya seems mostly unchanged after the disaster.
